Re: License Application

Dear Ms. Denton:

As you may be aware, the Federal Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994, 18 U.S.C. § 1033, prohibits a person with a felony conviction for a crime involving dishonesty or a breach of trust from engaging in the business of insurance. However, a person affected by this law may petition the Commissioner of Insurance in the person's domiciliary jurisdiction for a "Letter of Consent". If granted, the Letter of Consent allows the person to lawfully engage in the business of insurance despite the prohibition contained in the federal statute.

In order for you to be eligible to receive your license, you must submit to the Department, within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter, a fully completed "Application for Written Consent" from the Commissioner to engage in the business of insurance.


As you are aware, our office requested that you provide us with a completed application. To date, you have failed to provide the foregoing information. As such, the Department wishes to advise you that you have an opportunity to withdraw your application.

In the alternative, if we do not hear from you within 10 days of this letter your application will be **denied** for violation of Miss. Code Ann. § 83-17-71(1) (a) (Supp. 2006) which provides that the Commissioner of Insurance may refuse to issue or renew a license for failure to provide "incorrect, misleading, **incomplete**, or materially untrue information in the license application."
